WHO WE ARE

We are an office of 150 people mandated by the *Auditor General Act* to examine and report publicly on the Government of Alberta's management of the public resources entrusted to it.

WHAT WE DO

We are the auditors of every ministry, department, regulated fund and most provincial agencies. We audit so that we can report on how well the government is managing its responsibilities and the province's resources. We provide independent assurance to the people of Alberta that public money is spent properly and provides value.

HOW WE DO IT

We look at government through the lens of Albertans and apply our professional expertise to provide conclusions on whether the province's financial statements are presented fairly and are free of material errors, misstatements or omissions. Through performance auditing, we also examine whether the management control systems and processes of government are working well and achieving desired results. Where we find systems and processes are not working as well as they could, we provide recommendations for improvement aimed at helping the government succeed in delivering what it has set out to do for the people of Alberta.

We report directly to the 87 Members of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, and through them, we serve the more than four million people who call Alberta home.
